### **General Conditions**

1. The last date for submission of offline applications is 26th June 2026, 05:00 PM IST. This date shall be treated as the cut-off date for all purposes, including age, qualification, experience, etc.
2. The maximum age limit is 35 years for PA as on 26th May 2026, i.e., the closing date of applications. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates. Age relaxations as per Government of India rules will also apply to Ex-Servicemen, Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD), widows, divorced women, and women judicially separated from their husbands and who are not remarried.
3. The prescribed essential qualifications are the minimum

requirement, and mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for an interview. If the number of applications received is large, it may not be possible for the Selection Board to interview all candidates. The Centre may restrict the number of candidates called for interview to a reasonable limit based on desirable qualifications, academic performance, relevant experience, or other benchmarks decided by a duly constituted screening committee. No correspondence will be entertained with candidates who are not called for the interview.

4. Canvassing in any form and/or bringing influence, political or otherwise, will lead to disqualification. No interim correspondence/inquiry will be entertained.
5. Candidates employed in Government/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous bodies must produce a valid 'No Objection Certificate' from their employer at the time of interview.
6. Experience will be counted only after completion of the essential academic qualifications. A completed doctorate degree will be considered equivalent to three years' experience (where the doctorate is not listed as an essential qualification).
7. In case a candidate has obtained the above degree while in service, only the service period will be counted as experience. No additional weightage will be given for acquiring a doctorate degree in such cases.
8. Selection for the posts shall be based on the performance of screened-in candidates in the interview. The Director, CESHS, reserves the right to decide the mode of interview (offline/online), and in case of online mode, through any suitable video-conferencing platform.
9. A walk-in-interview will be held on 30th June 2026. Only those candidates who are shortlisted after evaluation of the applications will be contacted and permitted to appear for the interview. No correspondence will be entertained with candidates who are not shortlisted.
10. Offline applications submitted without a photo, signature, and scanned copies of certificates will be rejected.
11. Selected candidates are liable to serve in Arunachal Pradesh.
12. No travelling advance will be paid for attending the interview.
13. Candidates must make their own arrangements for their stay. CESHS will not provide accommodation.
14. The Director, CESHS, reserves the right to cancel the recruitment process at any stage without assigning any reason and to alter the number of posts in each category. The shortlisting criteria may also be revised depending on the number of applications received.

15. Discrepancies in certificates or concealment of facts will lead to disqualification/termination or debarment from future recruitments, as applicable. Non-production of original certificates at the time of the interview will also disqualify the candidate.
16. Production of original certificates at the time of the interview is mandatory. Candidates currently employed in another organization must provide proof of current employment with a service/experience certificate issued by the employer. An appointment order will not be accepted as proof of employment.
17. All project positions are purely temporary and project-based. They do not entitle the candidate to any claim for regular/permanent employment at any stage. The contract may be extended periodically, subject to satisfactory performance.
18. All future updates/amendments regarding this recruitment shall be uploaded only on the CESHS website. Candidates are therefore advised to visit the official website regularly.
19. Application procedure: The application process is completely offline. Copies of certificates supporting educational qualifications, date of birth, disability, caste (SC/ST/OBC/EWS), experience, no-objection certificate, photograph, and signature must be enclosed with the application. Original certificates must be produced at the time of interview or whenever required. If the certificates are in a language other than English or Hindi, an attested translation must be provided.
